

ZOO SIGHT WORD SEEK & FIND ACTIVITY

In advance of your trip to the Zoo, gather materials and create the activity. Both pre-school, kindergarten classrooms, and families will enjoy this activity.

MATERIAL LIST

- Clear pastic ID badge holder with clip (landscape/horizontal layout)
- White cardstock (cut to fit badge holder)
- Colored cardstock (cut to fit badge holder)
- Marker

DIRECTIONS

- With a marker, write a sight word on each piece of colored cardstock.
- With a marker, write each student's name on a piece of white cardstock.
- Insert the colored sight word card into the ID Badge, facing out. Insert the white name card facing the back of the ID Badge holder.



- Take the students around the Zoo, bringing them to print-rich habitats. They should be wearing their sight word badge on their shirt. The students point to their sight word (they must find it themselves with no outside help). It is okay to give hints about the general location of the word on a sign.
- As they learn the sight words, you may also need to include more words. For example, if you have 11 students, there are 16 sight words. You can switch out words on occasion so that all 16 are at some point represented.
